TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THE PROGRAM AND NEED-BASED GRANT:

Students must have a minimum 2.5 GPA, no business office holds, in good academic standing and enrolled as a full-time MIAD student at time of application and the semester prior to program start. Awarded grants are applied towards the balance owed only. Grant money may NOT be used for the deposit.

Students should be aware that MIAD scholarships may not be applied to summer travel programming. Those interested in pursuing financial aid options should contact the Financial Aid office right away to determine individual eligibility.

Interested students must submit a COMPLETE application package for the 2025 Summer Study Abroad Program by **November 17, 2025 12 noon to be considered.**

WHAT DO I DO WITH MY COMPLETED APPLICATION?

Deposit can be in a form of a check or can be paid in the Business Office with cash or credit card. Attach receipt from business office with application. Checks should be made out to MIAD with specific program identified in note line.

ONLY COMPLETE APPLICATIONS will be accepted. Space is limited. The quality of a student's Statement of Interest, GPA, year in school, references and date of submitted application and permission of instructors will determine acceptance into the specific program.

Students accepted into the program will be required to complete and sign a commitment letter in early December and submit this within 5 days of receipt. Once the commitment letter is signed, the \$800 deposit is non-refundable. (If MIAD cancels the program, the deposit WILL be refunded.)
