Good morning! Welcome to the Milwaukee Institute of Art & Design, MIAD. The college is honored to host the kickoff of Milwaukee's designation as one of the Top 12 ArtPlaces in America.

We are also honored to have been an anchor of the Third Ward since 1974.

If you were standing here then, you would have seen many abandoned warehouses. You would also have seen our four-year college, theater groups and a few galleries.

But would you have seen *exactly* what they saw? They saw the promise of the Third Ward as a hotbed of creative talent, as a key driver of economic and societal innovation.

During the ensuing years, MIAD alumni fueled the growth of local design firms, founding many, and providing the talent for local galleries.
