Robert Sabuda, a leading pop-up book creator and paper engineer, will present "The Science and Art of Paper Engineering," at 6 p.m., with a short Q&A session moderated by WUWM Lake Effect Producer and Co-Host Bonnie North to follow. A book signing, hosted by Boswell Book Company, and a reception, is from 7:15-8 p.m. The MIAD Creativity Series is free and open to the public.

Sabuda's recent books, such as those depicting the stories of *The Wonderful Wizard of Oz, Alice in Wonderland*, and *Peter Pan*, have received wide popular and critical acclaim. He is a two-time recipient of the *New York Times* Best Illustrated Book Award and has over five million books in print. He is the co-creator of the *Encyclopedia Prehistorica* pop-up trilogy, which has been translated into over 25 languages worldwide.

Sabuda appears regularly on the television programs *The Today Show, Good Morning America* and *Martha Stewart*, where he shares his enthusiasm for creativity, children's book art and literature. He has also been an associate professor at Pratt, where he began a program in Paper Engineering that continues to encourage the next generation of paper artists.
